2021 average tech salary

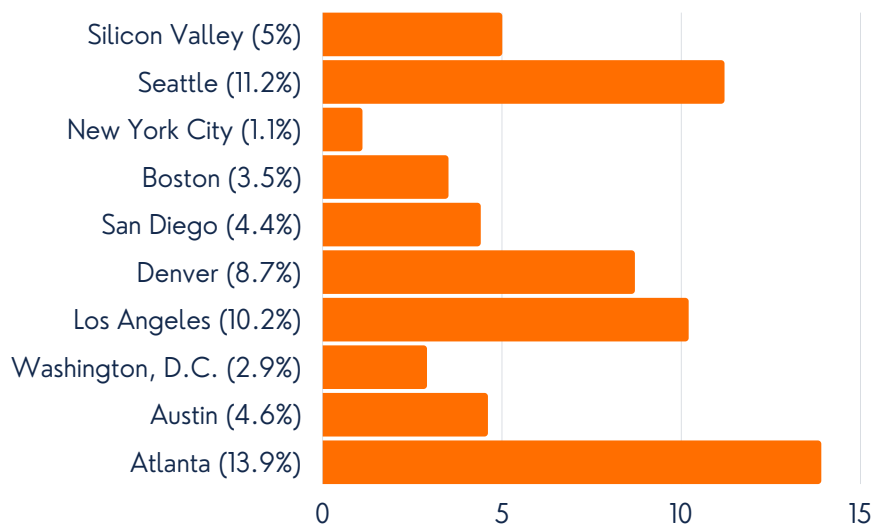

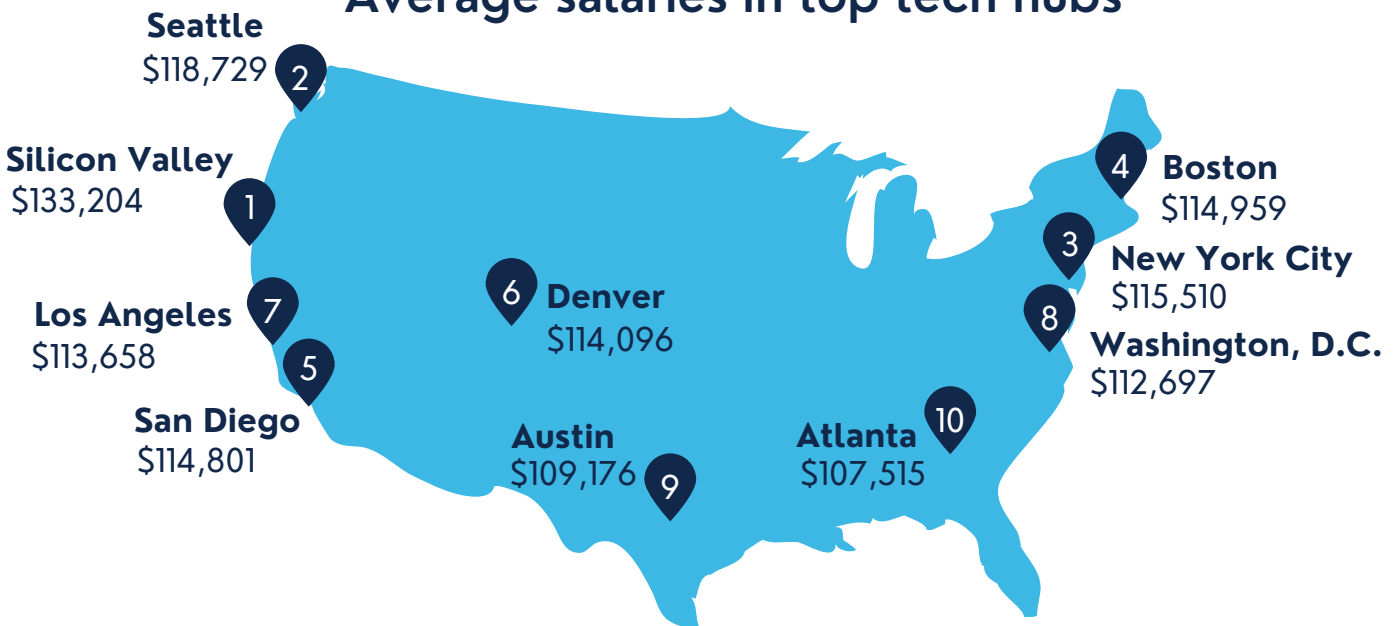
The average tech salary in 2021 increased \$6,707 year-over-year vs. 2020.

Top 10 tech hubs (by average salary)

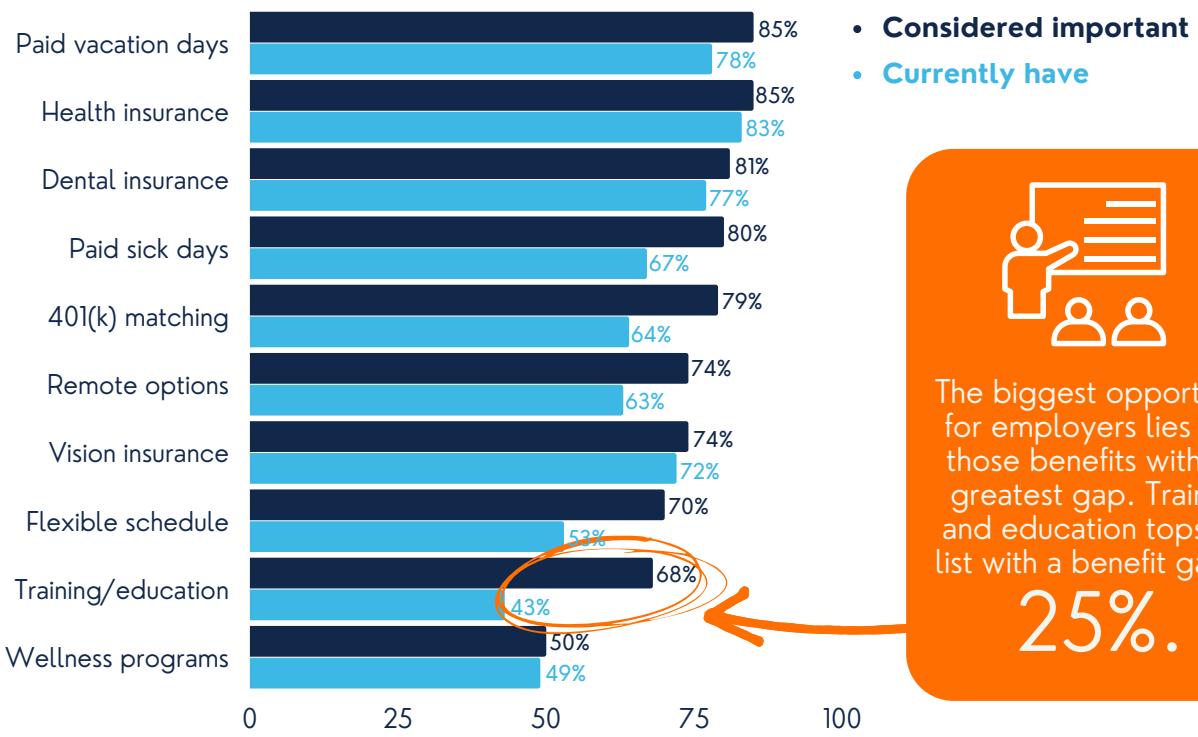
% increase from 2020 to 2021



Average salaries in top tech hubs



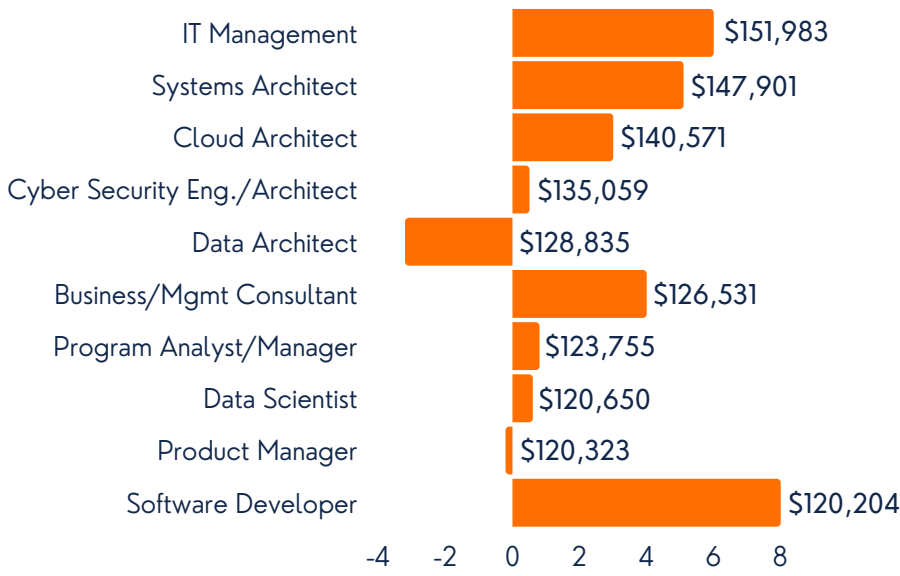
The benefit gap: benefits employees have vs. those they find important



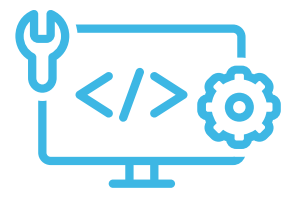
The biggest opportunity for employers lies with those benefits with the greatest gap. Training and education tops the list with a benefit gap of **25%**.
